

**Title:** "King Jesus the Last Ruling Monarch, Will Lift Up The Head of The Jew & Christians"

### **Summary:**

After listening to Pastor Dr. Geeter's sermon, I walked away with one clear message: Jesus is King - yesterday, today, and forever. The entire sermon centered around Psalm 110 and other supporting scriptures to show that Jesus is not only our Savior, but the final ruling Monarch. Pastor Dr. Geeter explained that Jesus is both David's Son and David's Lord, that He is reigning right now as our High Priest, and that one day He will return as King to rule for 1,000 years. Listening to this message felt both encouraging and serious. It reminded me that as Christians, we are not just waiting for Heaven but we are serving a reigning King right now and preparing for His return.

### **3 Key Points:**

#### **1. New Testament Reference: Jesus Proposed the Question to the Pharisees**

One of the first major point Pastor Dr. Geeter made was about Jesus confronting the Pharisees using Psalm 110. Jesus asked them how David could call the Messiah "Lord" if the Messiah was simply David's son. Pastor Dr. Geeter explained that this question showed that Jesus is more than just a descendant of David but He is divine. He existed before David and yet came through David's line. The Pharisees could not answer because they did not want to accept who Jesus truly was. Listening to this made me think about how important it is, as Christians, to fully accept Jesus as Lord and not just acknowledge Him with our words. It is easy to say we believe in Jesus, but this passage shows that recognizing Him as Lord means we submit to His authority. Pastor Dr. Geeter made it clear that Jesus was giving them an opportunity to see the truth and acknowledge him as the Divine Messiah but their hearts were hard. As Christians, we should not harden our hearts when truth is presented to us.

#### **2. The Expectation of Jesus Is Seating and Reigning as the High Priest NOW**

The second key point Pastor Dr. Geeter taught was that Jesus is already reigning now as our High Priest. He explained that Jesus holds three offices - Prophet, Priest, and King. Jesus fulfilled the role of Prophet while He was on earth preaching and teaching. Right now, He is fulfilling the role of High Priest at the right hand of the Father. Listening to this reminded me that as Christians, we have direct access to God through Jesus. We do not need to go through an earthly priest. Jesus understands what we go through because He lived on this earth. He experienced hunger, pain, rejection, and suffering. That means when we pray, we are talking directly to someone who truly understands. Pastor Dr. Geeter also made it clear that since Jesus is reigning now, we should live like it. As Christians, we are called to live holy lives, to obey God's Word, and to take our faith seriously. This point felt very practical and it reminded me that my daily life should reflect that I serve a reigning King.

### **3. At His Second Coming, Jesus Will Ultimately Fulfill His Office of King for 1,000 Years**

The third key point focused on Jesus' return. Pastor Dr. Geeter described Jesus coming back not as a Lamb, but as a Lion. He used Proverbs and Micah to show that a lion is strong, fearless, and does not back down. When Jesus returns, He will come in power and authority. Psalm 110 says His enemies will be made His footstool, meaning He will have full control and complete victory. Listening to this part of the sermon reminded me that as Christians, we have hope even when the world feels chaotic. There is so much sin and injustice around us, but evil will not win in the end. Jesus will return and make all things right. Pastor Dr. Geeter also emphasized that there are only two sides - the Lord's side and the devils side against Him. There is no middle ground. That made the message feel urgent. As Christians, we believe that now is the time to accept God's grace and live faithfully before Christ returns.

#### **Conclusion Overview**

Overall, after listening to Pastor Dr. Geeter's sermon, I was reminded that Jesus is in control of all of history. He was Lord before David, He is reigning now as our High Priest, and He will return as King. As Christians, we are called to stay ready, stay faithful, and stay grounded in scripture. The message encouraged me to take my walk with Christ seriously and to remember that one day every knee will bow and every tongue will confess before Him. King Jesus deserves our obedience and our worship now, not just when He returns.
